Plastic

3 P's SNACKS: Peanuts, Popcorn, Pretzels to include any brand of nuts, popcorn or pretzels

AIR, HOME & LAUNDRY CARE: to include plastic air fresher containers & cartridge caps, flexible packaging from home cleaning wipes, **(no baby wipes)** flexible packaging from laundry capsules & pods & dishwasher tablets, tinted rigid tubs for home cleaning.

ASTHMA PUMPS

BABY FOOD POUCHES with lids, all brands

BISCUIT WRAPPERS (sweet & savoury biscuits)

BREAD BAGS any brand **loaves of bread only**

CAKE WRAPPERS flexible plastic, any brand

COFFEE PACKAGING jar lids, individual sticks & refill packs **KENCO ONLY**

CRISP PACKAGING all brands, multi packs & similar snacks like Wotsits, Monster Munch, etc.

ELLAS KITCHEN SNACK PACKS **No other brand**

MILK BOTTLE TOPS (phasing out over next 6 months) now you can put these **inside the milk bottle** and recycle with the Council.

OTHER BOTTLE TOPS (phasing out over next 6 months) now can put these **back on the bottle** and recycle with the Council

PENS, FELTS, MARKERS broken, any kind

PERSONAL CARE & BEAUTY PACKAGING empty please, including plastic pots & lids & plastic tubes, all brands

PET FOOD POUCHES & FLEXIBLE PACKAGING
wet food pouches must be washed & dry

PLASTIC RING CARRIERS from 4 / 6 packs

TASSIMO & L'OR PODS & FLEXI PACKAGING **not cardboard as it can be recycled with the Council**

TOOTHBRUSHES & PLASTIC PACKAGING

TOOTHBRUSH HEADS from electric toothbrushes

TOOTHPASTE TUBES any brand **not metal tubes**

WATER FILTERS any brand

Metal

Aluminium foil must be clean & dry

Batteries **take to supermarket**

Brass

Copper wire & any small pieces

Keys

Metal lids jars, beer bottles, wine bottles **no lids from food cans**

Textiles

Bags handbags, holdalls, etc

Belts

Bras

School Uniform

Shoes

Textiles clothes, sheets, towels, linens, etc **no branded textiles, no scraps of material, no duvets**

Other

Corks

Foreign currency notes & coins

Glasses **prescription only**

Hearing aids inc batteries

Jewellery including broken

Make-up new or used

Mobile phones working or not

Old British currency notes & coins

Postage stamps **need 5mm border around entire stamp**

Pringle tubes inc paper seal and plastic lid, **no other tubes**

Printer cartridges

Rubber bands **not broken**

Take away coffee cups & lids

Watches working or not

Plastics Recycling

Brighton & Hove City Council

Plastic bottles ONLY

Remember this means all types of bottles



Milk bottles: wash, squash and **PUT THE LID INSIDE**



All other bottles: wash, squash and **REPLACE THE LID**



If you put wrong or dirty items in your recycling, you cause contamination. More than 10% contamination and it gets incinerated - what a waste of time and effort.

Reduce

The process to recycle plastic is **EXPENSIVE** and **ENERGY INTENSIVE**

Plastic is Collected



Prepared and checked for contamination

Too much contamination and the load is burnt or buried

Moved to recycling company



Plastic is recycled

This is **NOT** sustainable

Can you reduce the amount of plastic you use?

Perhaps look at one type at a time

It's worth the effort!

Magpie Recycling

Magpie is a co-operative and complements the council recycling service

They offer a weekly collection (where available) £25 per quarter
Their opt-in service costs £1.80 per sack (collected when you have filled 2 sacks). Please **DO NOT** use them for plastic only recycling.

Supermarkets

Check whether your local supermarket has a scheme



Only deposit items listed on the bins



Only deposit clean items

Breaking the rules causes contamination and may lead to the removal of bins

For example, ASDA Brighton Marina collects:

- Carrier bags
- Bags for life
- Bread bags
- Produce bags
- Frozen food bags
- Toilet roll film
- Shrink wrap
- Bubble wrap
- Drinks multi-pack wrap
- Cereal bag inners
