The reason for our closure, after 17 years, is that many of our schemes have become unsustainable due to rising costs, falling income, etc. Moving forward we will focus on our education programme, “The Art of Sustainable Living” based on the 10 principles of One Planet Living.

REUSE & RECYCLING LIST

BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL KERBSIDE 7 COLLECTION

Brighton & Hove City Council operate 2 core services. They **COLLECT** 7 items from your kerbside or communal bins and, by arrangement, will **COLLECT** bulky items from your home. There is a fee for bulky items. They also operate Household Waste & Recycling Centres at Wilson Avenue and Old Shoreham Road, where you can **DROP OFF** over 150 different items.

It is very important that you know the **KERBSIDE 7** to minimise contamination which wastes money and valuable resources. Here is your **KERBSIDE 7**:

1. **PAPER** - no shredded as it clogs up the machinery at Hollingdean. You can take small amounts to the “tip”
2. **CARDBOARD** - it is important to break down large boxes into small pieces.
3. **METAL TINS / CANS** – food tins [place lids inside and squash tin to keep them inside] and drinks cans
4. **METAL LIDS / LARGE ONLY** - lids off jars. **No small lids, eg. wine bottles, beer bottles, etc.**
5. **METAL AEROSOLS** - remove the lid
6. **GLASS** - bottles and jars go in a separate bin without their lids.
7. **PLASTIC BOTTLES ONLY** – put the milk bottle lid inside the bottle [the thread is too weak to remain on the bottle]. All other bottles put the lid back on. **NO OTHER PLASTIC OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER.**

PLASTIC: we appreciate that it is frustrating not to be able to recycle more plastics like other councils do in the UK. Please understand, “pots, tubs and trays” are very low-quality plastics. Recycling them takes a lot of energy to give them one extra life before the plastic deteriorates and requires incineration. It is a practice which is unsustainable. While other councils offer this service, some of their plastic is being shipped over seas to be recycled which is unsustainable.
